2009 NASCAR SPRINT PIT CREW CHALLENGE CHAMPIONS APPEARING ON FOX AND FRIENDS

HARRISBURG, N.C. (April 29, 2010) – The 2009 NASCAR Sprint Pit Crew Challenge Champions – the No. 31 Caterpillar Chevrolet pit crew of Richard Childress Racing – will appear on FOX and Friends Monday, May 3 at approximately 7:50 a.m. ET.

The No. 31 Caterpillar Chevrolet pit crew will perform a pit stop on national TV, marking the first time a NASCAR Sprint Cup Series™ pit crew will be featured on a national morning show.

The 2009 champions captured the team title last year setting a new event record with a time of 22.115 seconds. The 2010 fan-friendly, pit-crew competition between the top-24 NASCAR Sprint Cup Series™ pit crews is scheduled for 7 p.m. EDT Wednesday, May 19 at Time Warner Cable Arena.
